IMPORTANT INFORMATION 2010

Thank you for taking the time to carefully review the following information. Doing so will help us to deliver a smooth closing/opening of your pool. Pools are booked on a first come, first served basis. Avoid disappointment with filled weeks, book early!

PRIOR TO CLOSING

- Water balance must be maintained with a water test 1-2 weeks prior to close date
- Keep pump & skimmer baskets free of debris
- Vacuum pool (if pool requires Mayfair to vacuum before closing an extra charge will apply)
- Make sure winter cover and winterizing accessories are accessible to the crew
- Ensure timers for pumps and switches for lights are turned off
- Note: we are unable to close solar systems

AFTER POOL IS CLOSED

- We are responsible within 48 hours after closing for any waterbags or winter covers that need to be replaced or re-attached (due to weather or leaking waterbags). After 48 hours our regular service rates apply.

PRIOR TO OPENING

- Leave your gate unlocked
- Make sure garden hose is available and tap is turned on inside the house
- Breakers for the pool equipment are turned on so that pool can be started
- Leave vacuuming equipment out for us to use to start pool (not vacuum)

UPON COMPLETION OF OPENING

- The garden hose will be left on to fill pool. **This must be monitored by the homeowner and shut off when the level reaches the proper running level.**
- The vacuum hose will be left in the skimmer. This can be removed when water is at appropriate level.
- If an Opening Vacuum has been booked, it will take place several days after the pool has been running, to allow for debris to settle and opening chemicals to take effect.
- Bring a water sample to be analyzed after water has been circulating at least 48 hrs.
- If any problems are found at the opening that prevent us from starting your pool or leaving it running, you will be notified by the opening crew or office staff. A service call can then be arranged to assess and repair the problem at our normal service rates. Service calls are not done at the time of opening.
- Leaves and debris from the top of the winter cover will be placed in paper lawn waste bags and left for you to dispose of. Bags will be left at the side of the house unless we are asked to take them to the curb.
- For Salt Pools: The chlorine generator will not be turned on. Do not turn generator on until the manufacturer's recommended level of salt and temperature has been reached. The proper levels for your system will be printed in the owner's manual.
- If we are unable to complete the opening due to issues such as chlorinator or brominator not left out, power/water not turned on and a return visit is required regular service rates will apply.

ATTENTION TORONTO RESIDENTS

In order for Mayfair to comply with the City of Toronto Wastewater Discharge By-Law extra measures must be taken. Please refer to the sanitizer category that describes you.

Chlorine/Bromine Pools-an extra charge of \$25 plus HST will be applied to neutralize the chlorine/bromine when pumping pools down for winterizing (the by-law states levels must not exceed 0.01 milligrams per Litre).

Salt Pools- as salt water cannot be neutralized and the by-law states the acceptable level of salt in wastewater is zero, we have to deal with lowering the water in a different way. Here are the options that are available to you:

- a. The homeowner can have their water lowered 2-3 inches below the return face plates prior to us arriving for the scheduled closing.
- b. Mayfair will supply a submersible pump and set it up to drain to either a toilet or laundry tub (we must have access to the home). This would be done a couple of days prior to your closing day to allow time for the water to lower to the appropriate level. Our pumps will be set to shut off when the water level is at the proper level but the location to where the water is draining to, inside the home, must be monitored by the homeowner and is solely their responsibility. An additional fee of \$150 plus HST will apply.
- c. Water can be drained onto your own property. However, salt water can be destructive to plant life and may kill grass and plants. As well, the water must not be allowed to flow from your land onto any street, sidewalk or neighbouring property.
